Quite often life doesn't allow us to do the things we have planned. But it's not rare that we discover the work we end up doing is far more enjoyable than we ever hoped. This was the case with Yvonne Fosse, a 28 year old Norwegian from Bergen. Her original ambition was to study business and public relations. To pay her way through school she took a job as a waitress in a night club called "Engelen". Yvonne was fascinated by the night life world. Her experience at "Engelen" so impressed her that when she completed her schooling the summer of 1992, she started to work as a barmaid in a prestigious Bergen restaurant called 'The Banco Rotto', whose main claim to fame is its incredible 40-metre long "L"-shaped bar manned by a staff of seven barmen and barmaids. At present she is extremely happy with her work and believes that being a barmaid is far more challenging: "I must say that, in Norway at least, barmaids have made a big contribution to the bartending profession, though it was a tough battle before we were fully accepted. It wasn't until 1979 that the first barmaid was admitted to the Norwegian Barmen's Association".
